\$500 Lineworker Training Scholarship

Eligibility guidelines

1. High school seniors may submit an essay for the \$500 scholarship.
2. The student should be planning to attend an Electrical Power Distribution program at a technical college in Wisconsin, Michigan or Iowa.
3. Essays should be on the theme: *A Career as an Electric Lineworker: My path to Success*. The essay should include why the applicant desires a career in the electric field, and why he/she should be awarded the scholarship. Essays should be one to two pages — typed and double-spaced — and include the following information on the cover:

Student's first and last name
Home address
Phone number
Name of parent or legal guardian

4. A letter of recommendation is requested from a teacher, counselor or employer that addresses the applicant's skills that are pertinent to the job (ex. manually dexterous; in good physical condition; willing to work at all heights and in all weather; able to comprehend and follow written instructions; safety conscious). Please include the name, position and phone number of the reference.
5. Deadline for submitting applications is April 16, 2010. Please submit all essays and the completed application form to the high school guidance office.
6. Awards will be announced in early **May 2010**.
